Grammar

Reading Skills

Effective tools and strategies aimed at bettering reading skills. Use of linguistic tools to crack the test paper and decipher question types.

Writing

Introduction to and intensive training in writing Essays, Reports (for the Academic test) and Letters (for the General test).

Step-by-step development of writing skills, ranging from grammar and vocabulary, to content development and structuring of the composition.

Listening Skills

Strategic tools, a systematic approach to "preparing" for and improving listening comprehension. Graded Language Laboratory Exercises to ensure a high score.

Speaking Skills

Principles of composition, language production and organization of thought, used effectively to train in effective speech. Individual sessions with the trainer to address individual learning needs.
